- Work as part of a team including Speech-Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, and Communicative Disorders Assistants/Therapy Assistants
- Regularly communicate with supervising SLP or OT
- Creatively problem-solve to provide treatment programs catered to the client and setting
- Provide life skills training as the client works towards independence

- Background as an Educational Assistant, Child & Youth Worker, Social Service Worker, Developmental Support Worker, or similar post-secondary training in the helping professions
- Comfortable with technology, including video conferencing technology (training would be provided)
